Submission Guidelines

Submitting articles to “**Aboriginal Voices**” in the Prince George Citizen is a great way for you to influence opinions with the general public. We recommend that you follow these basic procedures in order for your thoughts to get published and reach your intended audience.

This column is intended for individual community members to express their concerns and opinions, and is not intended for organizations. It is our hope that we can start to eliminate stereotypes and keep the community abreast on current issues.

Introduction

- Include a sentence or two on yourself and your topic
- Do not go into detail in your introduction

Content

- Get to the point quickly
- Maximum of 800 words, try for between 600 to 800
- Explain your topic logically, present your points so nothing will be assumed
- Do not address more than one subject or your article may appear to be rambling

Closing

- One short paragraph that wraps up your article, and drives home any points you are trying to make
